

# FUTURE



A brand new Product Design Center is coming to the Newmar campus, helping us to continue redefining the RV ownership experience for our customers.

This state-of-the-art facility will house dedicated space for Newmar's drafting, electrical engineering, industrial design, interior design, and product development teams. It will enable Newmar to hire more team members, as it adds more shop space, larger employee break rooms, and more conference rooms and meeting spaces.

All of these improvements are intended to help different departments reach the same goal: to continue developing and refining our products so they provide the best possible experience for our customers.

"This is an ongoing investment that shows Newmar's commitment to the customer, helping us to put out the best quality product and the best designs that we can,"

says Ron Stichter, V.P. of Engineering and Product Development. "We're really focused on getting customer input on our products, and we'll be able to add staff more focused on product planning and development."

Kim Moore, Interior Design Manager, says she is excited about the lighting system she'll now have in her design center. "It will allow us to dial in any particular type of light, coach lighting or daylight. This helps us with wood finish selections as well as fabrics," she says. Plus, her team will now have the ability to work more closely with the engineering department on design projects.

Phase one of the facility was completed in November of 2016, creating 39,000 square feet of product mockup and design space. The second and final phase consists of an additional 48,000 square feet and is scheduled for completion in fall 2019.




# HOW TO TAKE BETTER CELL PHONE PHOTOS

These days, smartphone technology is so advanced that many people use their phones as their primary—or only—camera. And they're especially convenient when you're traveling. Since you'll likely always have your phone with you, whether you're hiking, golfing, or simply want a photo at dinner, these tips can help you make the most of your phone's camera for capturing those special memories.




## WIPE THE LENS

It may seem obvious, but keeping your phone clean helps your photos look better. A smudged or dirty lens can make your snapshots look dark, blurry, or unfocused. So take a second to wipe the lens with a soft cloth before you begin taking photos. Hint: even the bottom of your shirt will do in a pinch.



## SKIP THE ZOOM FEATURE

In certain situations, it's tempting to use your phone's zoom feature to make your subject appear closer. But resist that urge. Most phone cameras aren't designed to take good photos with the zoom feature, and you risk a blurry or grainy shot. Instead, simply try to get closer to your subject if you can.



## USE THE GRID LINES

When you open your phone's camera app, you'll see grid lines that visually divide the screen into nine squares of equal size. These help you balance your photos for better composition. For example, you can find the center of a photo using the grid. They also help you follow "the rule of thirds," a photography principle of placing the subject in an outer third of the image—not the center.

Before you know it, you'll be one with nature—and ready to plan your next outing.


On March 26, 2019, one of our newest and cutest members came into the office for his first day of work: a black Labrador Retriever puppy named Newmar.



# RECIPES

FOR EVERY  
MEAL

**T**hese simple recipes are designed to be prepared on your Newmar's cooktop. Each one requires just a few ingredients. And thanks to short prep and cook times, they're perfect to make whether you're on the road or at the RV park.

If your Newmar has an induction cooktop and you've never used one before, just remember: the key is in the prep work! These cooktops heat up quickly, so there's no downtime to chop, slice, dice, or measure your seasonings. Have your ingredients ready to go, and you'll get the hang of it in no time!



## WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- 2** cups frozen hash browns
- 2** large eggs
- 1/2** cup finely shredded cheddar
- 2** Tbsp. vegetable oil
- 1/2** Tbsp. butter

## HOW TO PREPARE

- 1** Crack each egg into its own small bowl or container.
- 2** In a nonstick skillet, heat butter and oil over medium-high heat.
- 3** When melted, add hash browns, cooking until golden and crispy. Season with salt and pepper.
- 4** Reduce heat to medium.
- 5** Using a wooden spoon, create two small "holes" in the hash browns. Carefully pour one egg into each hole. Sprinkle potatoes with cheese.
- 6** Cover skillet to let eggs cook until whites are firm.

Serve with a cup of fruit.



## WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- 4** slices sourdough bread
- 1/2** avocado, sliced
- 1** large tomato, sliced
- 4** slices sharp cheddar cheese
- 2** Tbsp. mayonnaise

## HOW TO PREPARE

- 1** Spread mayonnaise on one side of each slice of bread.
- 2** On the other side of each slice, place one slice of cheese, tomato, and avocado.
- 3** Heat a nonstick skillet on medium-low. Place mayonnaise side down and grill until bread is golden and cheese is melted. Flip and repeat on the other side.

Feel free to adjust the amount of ingredients to your liking!



## WHAT YOU'LL NEED

- 4** thin-sliced or pounded chicken breasts, 5-6 oz. each
- 1** Tbsp. lemon pepper seasoning
- 1/3** cup flour
- 2** Tbsp. butter

## HOW TO PREPARE

- 1** Mix flour and lemon pepper seasoning in a medium-sized bowl.
- 2** Press chicken into seasoned flour, coating evenly. If the flour isn't sticking well, moisten chicken with a little water.
- 3** In a nonstick skillet, melt butter on medium heat.
- 4** Cook chicken until heated through, about 4 minutes per side.






